Grade: Participants were provided with grade options for each initiative on a scale of 1-4. If the company completed each initiative at a best practise level they would score 4.



About this Report

About the Real Estate Social Value Index

RESVI is a framework used to measure and analyse the social and local economic value produced at an in-use real estate asset. The framework captures data on the asset's performance across the asset management, property management, supply chain and occupier operations. The RESVI framework consists of 67 social value initiatives (when including occupiers) that can be completed at an in-use real estate asset.

The RESVI diagnostic captures data on whether the initiatives are being completed. RESVI grade evaluates how well the social value initiatives are being carried out. Social and local economic value is calculated and verified using the National Social Value Framework, the UK's leading methodology of calculating Social Value.

UN SDGs and Social Value

Sitting behind the 17 Sustainable Development Goals are 169 Targets and 232 Indicators. SVP conducted a comprehensive mapping exercise to establish direct and indirect links between them and the Measures within the National TOMs.


This report estimates the social value contributed the 17 Goals. The TOMs uses a range of valuation types and these can be summarised into two categories: Investments (inputs and outputs) and Impacts (outcomes and impact). Local economic value is a sub-component of the outcome category and is reported separately.
