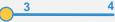

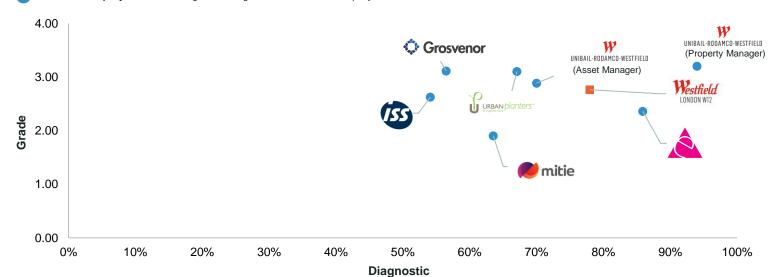
Social Value Performance at Westfield London in 2023 by Company

Diagnostic: If the participating company was achieving all possible Social Value outcomes they would score 100%.

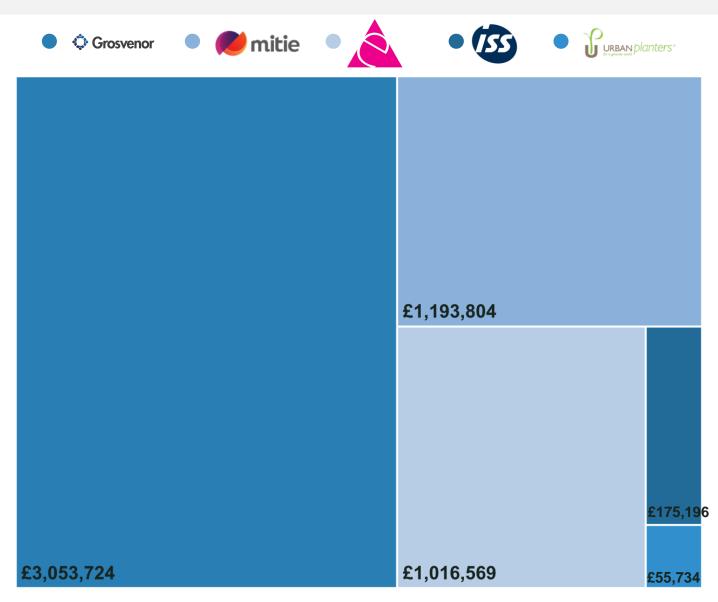
Grade: Participants were provided with grade options for each outcome on a scale of 1-4. If the company completed each initiative at a best practice level they would score 4.

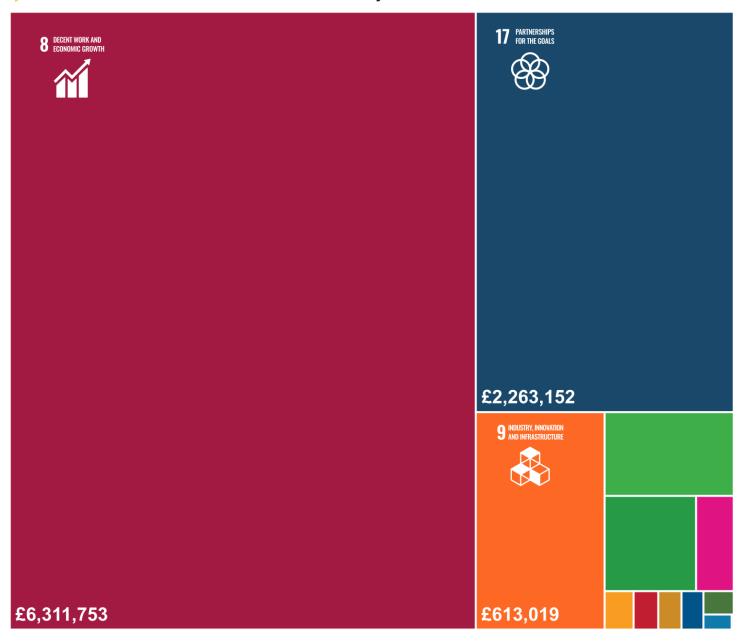

Opportunities for More Social Value in the Future

Asset Manager



The asset management team made significant strides in delivering Social Value. To further amplify their impact, the team could develop a process to collect and monitor feedback from core suppliers and occupiers regarding social value initiatives. The feedback would be invaluable in refining the asset's Social Value strategy.



Property Manager



The property management team demonstrated exceptional capacity and maturity of delivering Social Value at Westfield London. To further enhance Social Value, the team could focus on providing job opportunities to designated groups through targeted recruitment programmes, such as long-term unemployed, individual with disabilities and care leavers.



Suppliers



Suppliers possess a strong potential to enhance their Social Value contributions by implementing community health or wellbeing programmes either at the asset or in the neighbourhood. A mature approach involves collecting and reporting data on these initiatives and aligning the efforts with local needs.





About this Report

About the Real Estate Social Value Index

RESVI is a framework used to measure and analyse the social value produced at an in-use real estate asset. The framework captures data on the asset's performance across the asset management, property management, supply chain and occupier operations. The RESVI framework consists of 74 Social Value initiatives that can be completed at an in-use real estate asset.

The RESVI diagnostic is a capacity assessment looking at the scope of Social Value outcomes at the asset. The RESVI grading is a maturity assessment looking at how well developed the social value outcomes are. Social Value is calculated and assessed using the Social Value TOM System, the UK's leading methodology for calculating Social Value.

UN SDGs and Social Value

Sitting behind the 17 Sustainable Development Goals are 169 Targets and 232 Indicators. SVP conducted a comprehensive mapping exercise to establish direct and indirect links between them and the Measures within the TOM System. This report estimates the Social Value contributions to the 17 Goals.
